

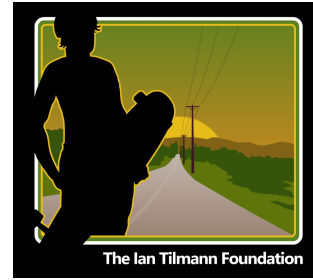

- Select a Skate Park for pick up and save \$7.00. You will be contacted by phone to pick-up the FREE Helmet at the skate park.
- Please allow **8-12 weeks** for your FREE Helmet to arrive.

Limited Impact Protection: No Helmet can protect the wearer against all possible impacts. Helmets can be penetrated by a sharp object. Helmets reduce or prevent many injuries. Impact forces, even in a common low speed accident, can result in serious injury or death. The energy absorbing materials used in the helmets crush on impact. Sometimes, the force of the impact can crush the material completely. When this happens some of the force is transferred to the head. If the force is great enough it can cause injury or death. Because every accident is different, it's impossible to predict when this might happen. Refer to the warning labels inside your helmet and the Owners Manual included with each helmet for further warnings and information.
